- Call to Order (Pam): 6:07
- Roll Call () Pam, Brandon, Michael, DeVontante, Breana, Al, Becky
- Last Meeting Update
  - Held Parent Meeting on 3.21
    - Great turnout. Parents asked questions and were attentive.
  - Held first Coaches Meeting on 3.21
    - A couple of coaches were in attendance, and Becky went over the expectations. Those coaches will not need to attend the next meeting on 4.13.
  - Went over the Skills Assessment setup that was on March 7 and 8 at the last meeting
